The Marge Boutwell Scholarship Fund has been established to provide a \$200 annual Scholarship for an Early Childhood Education or Interdisciplinary Studies (K-4 emphasis) major. The recipient will be selected annually by the College of Education and Behavioral Sciences Scholarship Committee and announced at the Annual Awards Banquet. Payment of the award shall be made in the amount of \$200 annually,

Selection Criteria:

1. A major in Early Childhood Education or Interdisciplinary Studies (K-4 emphasis).
2. Classification of junior in the Spring semester (at least 30 semester hours earned or having two remaining semesters).
3. Scholarship (minimum 3.0 GPA).
4. Campus and/or community participation.
5. Established meaningful professional goals.
6. Personal interview required upon request.
7. Completed application returned to Human Sciences Executive Aide by 4:00 pm on January 31, 2005.
8. Must be a full-time student during semesters for which scholarship is funded.
9. Submit university transcript that indicates current GPA.
