

RITA DAVENPORT HUMAN SCIENCES SCHOLARSHIP

The Rita Davenport Human Sciences Scholarship has been established to provide an annual scholarship for a Human Sciences major in the amount of approximately \$400. The recipient will be selected annually by a Human Sciences Scholarship Committee and announced at the annual Awards Banquet in the Spring. Payment of the award shall be made in the amount of \$200 for each of the fall and spring semesters.

Selection Criteria:

1. A major in one of the Human Sciences areas.
2. Classification of sophomore or junior in spring semester (at least 30 semester hours earned or having two remaining semesters).
3. Scholarship (minimum 2.8 GPA).
4. Demonstrated leadership in the areas of Human Sciences, campus life, and community involvement.
5. Established meaningful professional goals.
6. Financial need.
7. Completed application returned to Human Sciences Executive Aide by January 31, 2005.
8. Must be a full-time student during semesters for which scholarship is funded. One-half of the scholarship shall be awarded for each of the semesters.
9. Submit official university transcript that indicates current GPA.
10. Scholarship recipient will be required to attend the awards banquet.
